



MARQUES DE GRIÑÓN

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-Soils

They are acid soils (pH 5.5) comprised of decomposed granite sand (quartz, feldspar and mica) over a clay subsoil. It is interesting to observe how the terroir of each wine district, the meteorised granite in counterposition to the clay-limestone at Dominio de Valdepusa is reflected in the personality of our wines. The idiosyncrasy of El Rincón's soil profile lends its wines an unmistakable characteristic of elegance, giving them a more Atlantic profile.



-Geography and Climatology

Due to its geographical location and to being 485 metres above sea level, El Rincón is characterised by a continental Mediterranean climate, with very hot summers and very cold winters (mean annual temperature: 12-16°, mean rainfall: 450 mm./year, duration of frost period approximately 6 months and drought period 3-4 months).
